The project IGAEDIS is developed in the framework of the Institute for Medieval Studies (IEM) of NOVA FCSH, Portugal, in collaboration with the Faculty of Arts and Humanities of University of Coimbra and the Municipality of Idanha-a-Nova.

The main purpose of the project is to study the ancient city of Igaedis/Egitania (Idanha-a-Velha) and its relationship with the territory during the Roman and Early Medieval Periods.

The research team combine skills that support an interdisciplinary research on classical and medieval archaeology, medieval history, bioanthropology, art history, paleometalurgy, paleobotanics and zooarchaeology.

This international and interdisciplinary approach will provide not only knowledge on the social and territorial changing processes but also on new strategies of exercising power and administrative organization during a long period of time in the history of Beira Interior territory. Along with the scientific research, the project has a commitment to transfer and decode scientific knowledge to different types of publics, offering narratives supported in cooperation, integration and sustainability, supporting Idanha-a-Velha as an important spot for cultural tourism.
